- 2. How do you think about the word "holy"?
- 3. What is the connection between holy, law\Torah, and relationships?
- 4. Do you think of law\Torah as a book or as a tapestry?
- 5. What are some of the things that have written in the Torah of your life, your Home Church, or LBIC within the last year?

Practice for the week:

If Torah can be a tapestry of the narrative of your life with God, what would your pieces be? Maybe take some time, cut out some squares, and reflect on the significant pieces of your story, naming and describing them.
